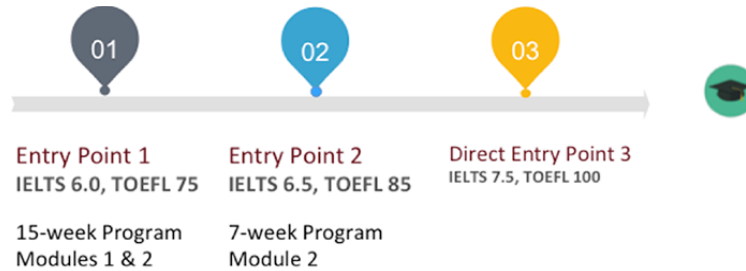


International Fellows Pathway Program: A Pathway to Graduate Study



PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The International Fellows Pathway Program is specially designed for non-native English-speaking international students who are ready for graduate study. It will prepare you for the rigors of graduate study by providing you with an excellent opportunity to refine your language, research, and participation skills. The program is aimed at helping you succeed in graduate-level courses and adapting to the expectations of American academic and business culture.



ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

You must first be admitted to a CGU academic program to be eligible for the International Fellows Pathway Program.

- Module 1: TOEFL iBT 75+ (Writing section 19+) /IELTS 6.0 (No section < 5.5)
- Module 2: TOEFL iBT 85+ (Writing section 21+) /IELTS 6.5 (No section < 6.0)

PATHWAYS TO CGU GRADUATE STUDY

- A GPA based on a 4-point scale will be used to grade students in this program.
- Students achieving a GPA of 3 will not be required to re-take the IELTS or TOEFL test prior to moving to their master's program.
- Students achieving less than 3 GPA must either re-take the IELTS or TOEFL test to meet the CGU direct-entry requirements or repeat the relevant program modules as advised.

SCHEDULE

The program is offered three times a year (May, September, January) with a 15-week intensive curriculum for students taking the full curriculum and a 7-week curriculum for students taking Module 2 only, depending on a student's level of language proficiency.
