



## ENGLISH SUCCESS PROGRAM

Admitted students who have met the Academic placement requirement but with TOEFL iBT scores below 80 (and subscores of 20 on writing and speaking), IELTS scores below 6.5, or PTE Academic scores below 53 will be required to take the following prescribed set of courses their first semester:

COJO 100 - Public Speaking (4 credits) or,  
COJO 105 - Communication in the Workplace (4 credits)  
ENGL 110 - Intensive Writing (4 credits)

Math course based on their math placement results and one general elective course. Please note that the length of your degree program may be extended by one semester in order to accommodate these required courses.
