International Foundation Year Programme

- · English language and academic skills preparation

- English skills preparation only
- IELTS entry requirement: 0.5 less than your main degree requirement
- Intakes in September (for progression to January programmes) and July (for progression to September programmes)

INTAKE DATES

Most programmes commence in September, while a few start in January. The Bridging Programme is offered in July.
