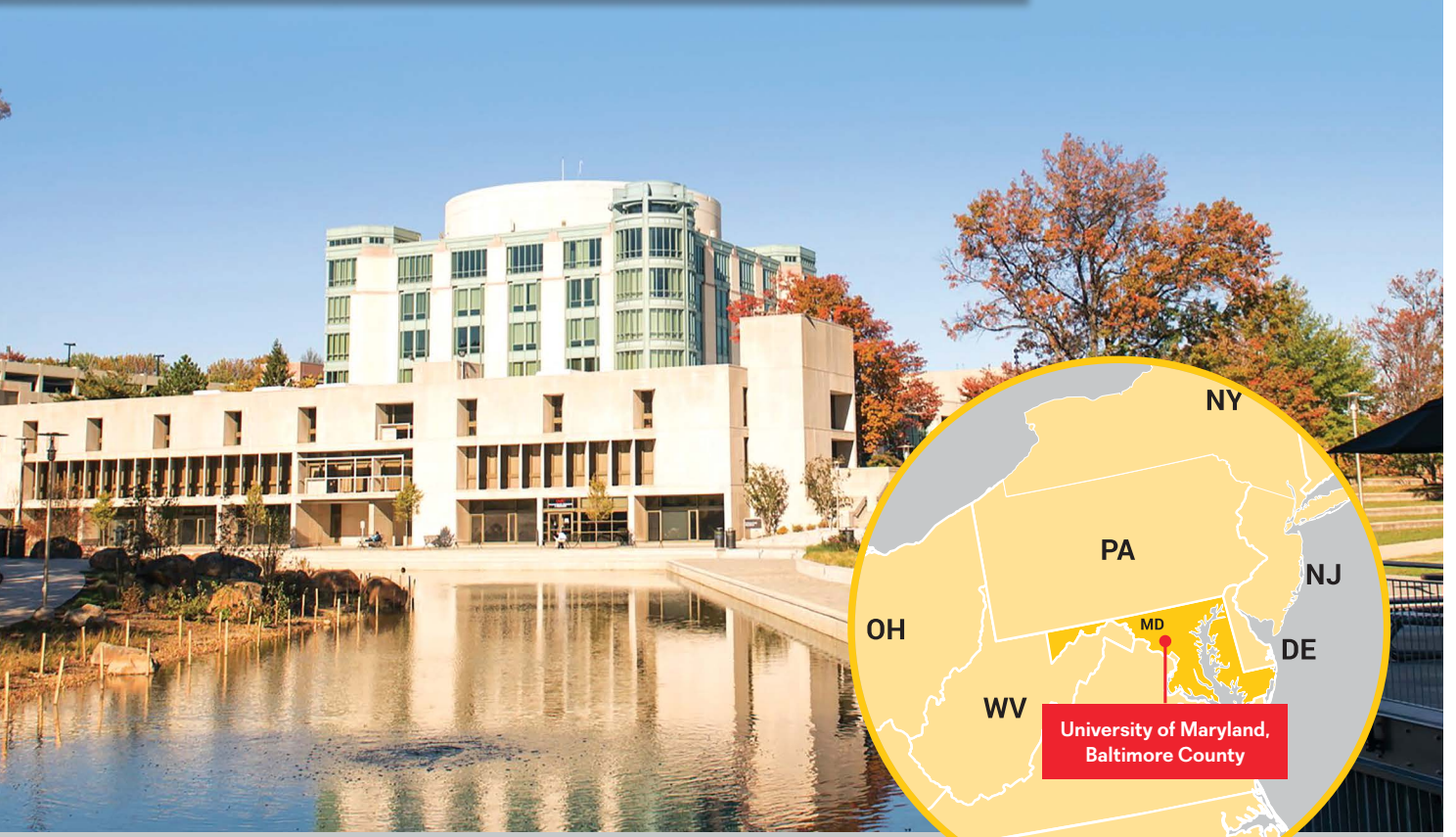

TUITION & FEES¹

- Tuition and fees from \$22,896 per year; assistantships available

- Programs are made up of 30-39 credits. Each credit costs \$1,132
- One-time EduCo scholarship of \$1,000 for all direct entry students. Applied evenly across year one

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A relevant bachelor's degree
- Minimum undergraduate GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- TOEFL score 80, IELTS 6.5 at minimum. Some programs require TOEFL 100, IELTS 7.5
- GRE test scores required by some programs
