Located in Vancouver, Canada, Acsenda School of Management is a private, post-secondary institution offering undergraduate degrees in business with the consent of the Minister of Advanced Education in British Columbia.

Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA)
– with concentrations in Accounting, Human Resources Management, International Business and Marketing.

Bachelor of Hospitality Management (BHM)
– includes a 6-month, 6-credit paid internship.

A quarterly semester system allows students to commence their studies in January, April, July or October (*two term starts per year for BHM).

Applicants with courses from an accepted post-secondary institution are eligible to apply for transfer credits. Evaluation by a recognized credential evaluation service is required.

Students may be admitted to our degree programs with a requirement to complete English for Academic Purposes and/or basic Math courses if they need additional support to satisfy the proficiency standards for these subjects. Students taking EAPP100 earn credit towards their degree as they upgrade their English reading, writing and speaking skills.

How to apply

The following must be submitted as a package.

1. Submit Application
 - a. Application for Admission Form
 - b. Copy of Passport
 - c. Copy of Academic Transcripts
 - An additional Letter of Intent and Curriculum Vitae are required when a degree is 10+ years old.
 - d. Proof of English Proficiency (e.g. IELTS, TOEFL, PTE, CELTA etc)

A Letter of Offer is issued along with a Deposit Quote. The deposit is equivalent to the estimated first term tuition costs and fees.

2. Payment of Quote
 - a. Make payment for the Deposit Quote
 - b. Provide a copy of the Transaction Receipt

A Letter of Acceptance is issued along with a Deposit Receipt. This letter is to be used as part of the study permit application with Immigration Canada.

Please Note: the deposit payment is non-refundable. The only exception is if the applicant is refused their study permit. In this situation the applicant will need to submit a withdrawal form along with a copy of their study permit refusal letter. Acsenda retains the \$150 application fee and a \$200 administrative fee. The remaining amount is refunded within 30 days.
