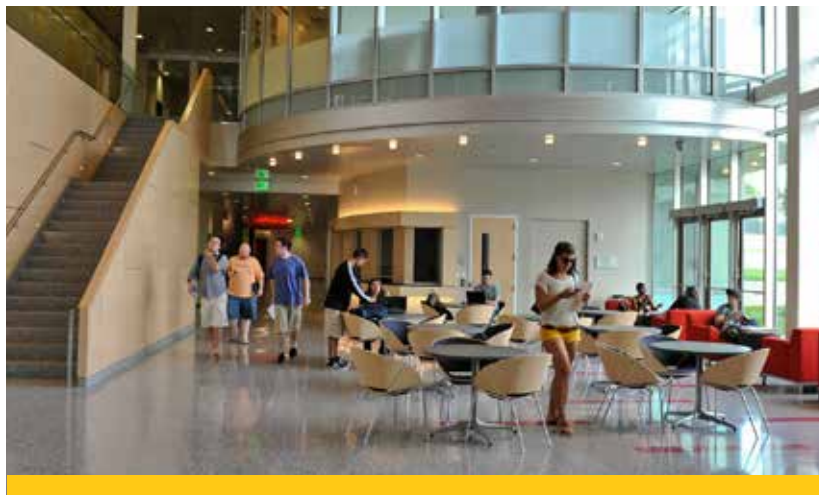

TUITION & FEES*

Tuition and fees from \$17,685 per year; assistantships are available. Students are charged a per credit hour rate for tuition and other fees. Programs are made up of 30 - 39 credits. Each credit costs \$1,047.

INTAKE DATES

There are two intakes each year: Fall and Spring. The Fall 2018 application deadline is 1 January 2018.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A relevant bachelor's degree
- Minimum undergraduate GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- TOEFL score in excess of 550 on a paper-based test, 213 on a computer-based test or 80 on an internet-based test; IELTS score of 6.5 at minimum
- GRE test scores required by most programs but not all
- All admissions will be reviewed by the Admissions Committee
