- Students with scholarships from Saudi Arabia: The ELI must receive a Financial Guarantee from the Saudi Arabian Cultural Mission (SACM) before we can issue your Form I-20. If you have an Admission Purpose Only letter, the ELI will give you a conditional acceptance and then issue the Form I-20 after you provide a final Financial Guarantee.

ELI PROGRAM COSTS

Full-Time Tuition: \$2,300 per 7-week session*

HOUSING

VISA

Most students will require an F-1 visa to study in the U.S. Students will receive visa information in the ELI admissions packet.

HEALTH INSURANCE

ELI students in F-1 visa status must purchase UMBC health insurance. Health care is not nationalized in the U.S., so it is more expensive than in many other countries. It is very important that students have appropriate insurance coverage. Students will receive information about UMBC student health insurance in the ELI admissions packet.
