Checklist of required application materials:

- Application form
- Original or attested copies of official academic records
- One letter of recommendation for undergraduate students; three letters of recommendation for graduate students
- Personal statement about yourself (minimum 300 words)
- Certification of finances (for visa purposes)
- Undergraduate minimum of 70 TOEFL/6.0 IELTS
- Graduate minimum of 80 TOEFL/6.5 IELTS
- GRE/GMAT for Graduate applicants
- Video interview, if requested by admissions staff
