

Admissions Guidelines

We are committed to providing an inclusive, supportive, and successful study experience for all our students. After analysis of attrition data from the last twelve months, and to ensure that students have the opportunity to succeed at our college, we have developed the following Admission Assessment Guidelines.

	Eligible	Ineligible
English Language	Meet Academic as per policy and English equivalent to IELTS 6.0 no band less than 5.5	
Study Gap	Students that have study gaps less than 6 months, excluding study breaks.	Students that have study gaps more than 6 months, excluding study breaks (can have opportunity to provide an SOP with supporting evidence) ¹
Academic History	Students that have completed an Australian Diploma within the last 6 months.	Students that have completed an Australian Diploma more than 12 months ago. ² Students that have results that indicate no attempt (marks less than 12/100) in more than 4 units of a Bachelor program.
Visa Status	Students on Student visas with more than 18 months until expiry.	Bridging Visas unless leading to a substantive student visa application. ³ Students on MRT Students with no Visa

¹ Students who have a study gap period of longer than 6 months (excluding university study break of November to March if student is enrolled at a university) will need to provide a written explanation as to the reasons for this study gap along with supporting evidence if available e.g. If the student can demonstrate (with evidence) that they left Australia during the six month period, it will not be classified as a study gap.

² Students who have completed an Australian diploma in the last 12 months automatically meet entry requirements as long as there is no study gap of longer than six months between when they completed the diploma and the date of application.

³ Previous studies to be assessed – applications may be declined if the students are on a bridging visa and have studied skill based diplomas/certificates in 485 visa streams for two years. All students on bridging visas need to produce the original visa application to show that the bridging visa was granted for a substantive student visa.

Final approval of all applications for admission to the college is delegated by the Academic Board to the Director of Admissions.
