  - Year 11: all courses, grades, and year shown
  - Year 12: all courses, grades, and year shown
- High school diploma/certification of graduation – English & Native Language
- For transfer students:** All past university/college transcripts
  - 2.0 GPA overall is **required**
  - 2.0 GPA during most recent college semester is **required**
- Passport Photocopy
- English proficiency
  - **For Full Admission:**
    - IELTS 6.0 with 5.5 writing subscore
    - TOEFL 70 with 20 writing subscore
    - SAT Reading score of 26. **Must send directly to UNL from SAT (school code: 6877)**
    - ACT English subscore of 20. **Must send directly to UNL from ACT (school code: 2482)**
  - **For CEAP program:**
    - IELTS 5.0-5.9 with writing subscore of 4.5 or higher
    - TOEFL 61-69 with writing subscore of 17 or higher
  - **For Intensive English Program (IEP)**
    - IELTS less than 5.0 and/or writing score of less than 4.5
    - TOEFL less than 60 and/or writing score of less than 17
