Undergraduate Admission Criteria

- Completed application form
- GPA of 3.3/4.0 (First Class Standing for British System)
- IELTS 6.0, TOEFL 79 or SAT EBRW 500+

* Pathway program available for students with a TOEFL 61+ or IELTS 5.0+

- SAT test scores of 1270+ (only required if applying for NJIT's merit-based scholarship ranging from \$10,000 to \$25,000)
- Recommendation letter (preferred)
- Personal statement (preferred)
- Architecture, Digital Design, Industrial and Interior Design require a portfolio

Graduate Admission Criteria

- Completed application form
- GPA of 3.0/4.0 (First Class Standing for British System)
- IELTS 6.5 or TOEFL 79
- GMAT or GRE test scores for Management and MBA programs

* Certificate program available for select programs for students who do not meet GRE/GMAT requirements for direct entry.

- Recommendation letter (1 for M.S., 3 for Ph.D.)
- Personal statement (preferred)
- Architecture and Infrastructure Planning require a portfolio and two additional recommendation letters
- First year scholarship of up to \$4,000
