How to Apply

1. CHOOSE

Find the course you want to study and select your preferred location.

2. PREPARE

Prepare the supporting documentation that you will need to apply, including:

- A colour photocopy of your passport
- Certified copies of previous qualifications, including secondary school transcripts
- Proof of your English language proficiency (if required)
- Your Statement of Purpose (SOP) (if required)
- Advanced Standing Form (if required).

3. APPLY

Apply online or complete the International Application for Admission Form and submit it via email with all supporting documents to: educocoapps@scu.edu.au

4. ASSESSMENT

If you are successful you will receive an International Offer Package via email, which includes details for how to accept your offer.

5. ACCEPTANCE

Accept your offer by following all the instructions in your International Offer Package. Make sure all the information in your International Offer Package is correct.

6. VISA

Check your visa requirements and apply for your visa. All students are required to meet the Australian Government's Genuine Temporary Entrant (GTE) Criteria: homeaffairs.gov.au

7. ARRIVAL

Once your visa is granted, you can travel to Australia and start your course at Southern Cross University!
